

RECTORY AND OFFICES

\$1,000,000



Originally constructed in 1940, this building includes the current Pastor's residence and parish offices. It occupies 6,325 square feet of ground floor space and includes an attached two-car garage. Construction is of wood framed walls with exterior plaster, conventional wood framed roofs with redwood sheathing and two-piece clay tiles. Limited gutters are present. Floors consist of wood framing with an under-floor space. Future work is to include seismic stabilization, infrastructure upgrades (electrical, plumbing, mechanical, and emergency backup power), new fire sprinklers, and any needed hazardous materials abatement that may be present

in some of the under-floor heating ducts. The windows and doors should also be upgraded as needed and the kitchen will be relocated.
