The South Addition Museum consists of many vestments from the time of Serra housed in wooden cases, an elaborate Italian Christmas scene, and other paintings and artifacts.

This Museum, which is actually a wing off the south side of the Basilica, needs seismic strengthening, infrastructure upgrades and general renovation of the interior surfaces.
